TRAVIS COUNTY VICTIM IMPACT PANEL (VIP) INFORMATION

(also referred to as a MADD class)

Requirements:

The Travis County VIP is held on the 1st, 3rd, & 4th Wednesday of each month.*

You should <u>PRE-REGISTER</u> for your VIP panel. You may do so here (https://maddvip.org/listing/blackwell-thurman-criminal-justice-center/). Note, as of 2-25-2020, the Travis County VIP information sheet says there is no pre-registration which is incorrect. Please pre-register using the link above.

You may attend without pre-registration but attendance is first come first served (on rare occasion there may be limited seating if there is high attendance). It is doubtful you will be able to attend with out pre-registering.

The VIP is held at 509 W. 11th Street, Travis County Courthouse (Blackwell Thurman Bldg.)

Arrive by 5:30 -5:45, to be in line when registration sign-in begins at 6:00. Attendees form a line in the courtyard outside the building entrance. Come dressed in respectful attire, cell phones turned off, no texting allowed. Inappropriate conduct will result in ejection and no completion. Stow bags and personal items under seat. Once you register, you cannot leave the building or be excused from the room. After the doors close there is no admittance. The program begins at 7:00 P.M. and ends at 8:30 P.M.

If you have pre-registered, you should arrive 30 minutes before the start time.

Bring a valid ID – photo ID such as drivers' license (Probation ID, Social Security card or Birth Certificate can substitute).

The cost is \$25.00 – bring a money order made to MADD (Parents accompanying their underage child are no charge). If you pre-register online, there is an additional \$2.00 fee.

Keep your receipt – it is the certificate proof of your attendance for the court and/or probation requirement (make a copy of take a picture of it for your records). Take a picture of your certificate and email it to your attorney (Chris@GBAFirm.com; Alan@GBAFirm.com; or Gene@GBAFirm.com)
